

Directions for Clock Faces by
Morgan's Mouse

Supplies Needed:

8" Plastic Clock (Dollars stores, Walmart, Kmart)
Paper (I like card stock)
Double Sided Tape
Scissors

Print your clock graphic and cut

Take the cover off the clock (I use a small butter knife)

Gently remove the hands of the clock (Note how they were placed on the center rod, as you will want to put them back exactly like that.)

Remove the paper the clock came with

Put the double sided tape on your new clock face and insert it on the clock.

Reassemble and

ENJOY

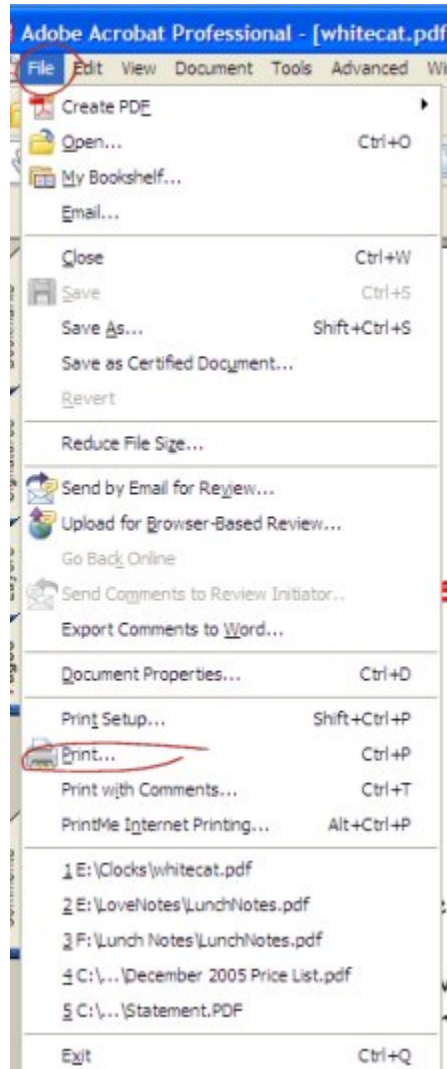

Print Help

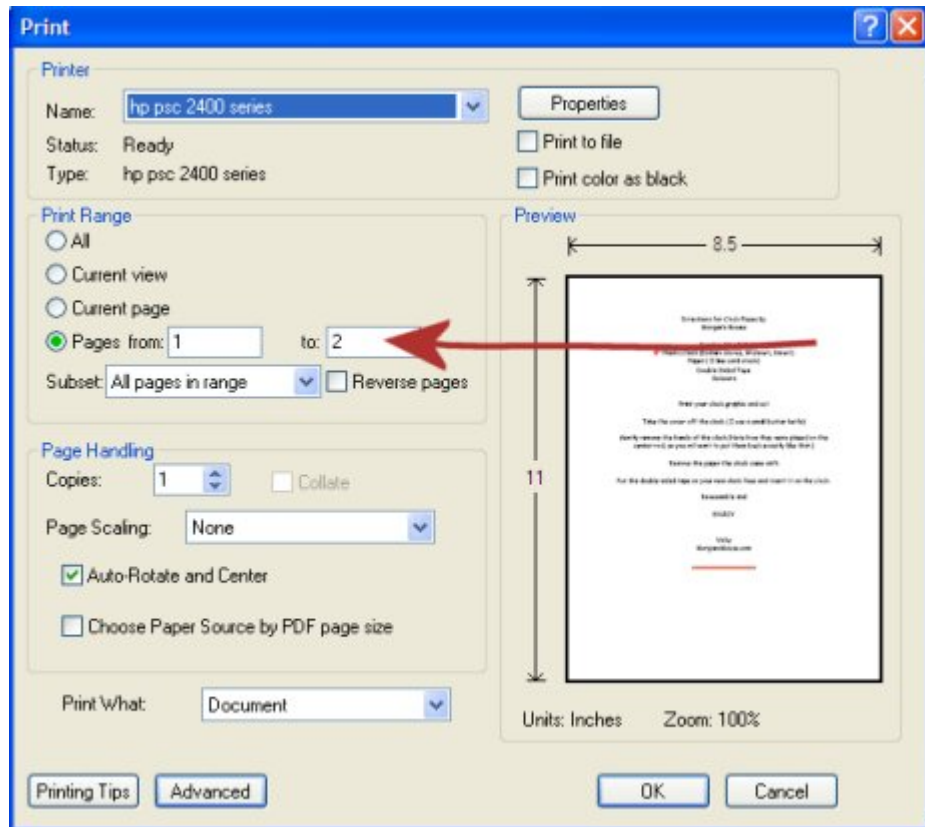
If you want to print only certain pages (and not all of the pages) in a pdf file, follow these instructions:

Go To File
Print



Your dialog box may be different than mine, however, just look for the Print command under file.

Tell the printer that you only want to print certain pages:



“Tick” off the Pages from choice... and let it know which pages you want to print. If you just want to print page 2, you would say: Pages from: 2 to 2.
